On May 12 we will have Erik Mann with Summit Assistance Dogs talking about service dogs for the disabled.

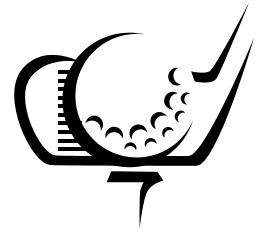

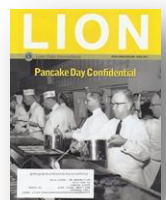
