

Programs: Last week we heard from Blake Buswell the new general manager of the Bellingham Bells. He showed off the new logo and jerseys. Take me out to...

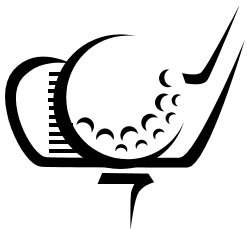

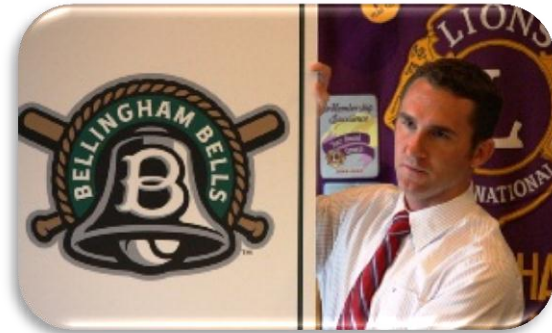
International Convention: Seattle, July 4th – 8th. Registration is closed, but you can register on-site for the same price.
