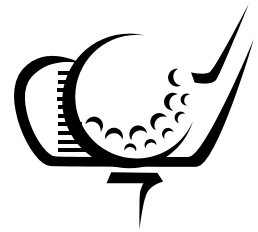


EARTH DAY

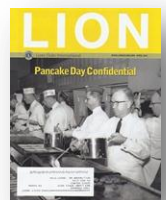
