



Camp Horizon Donation:

"WE SERVE"

Recently, the Bellingham Central Lions Club made a \$10,000 donation to Lions Camp Horizon. Your club's donation will be matched by private donors as part of the Camp Horizon Foundation's 50:50 campaign which seeks to raise \$50,000, matched by another \$50,000 from those private donors for a total of \$100,000. The BCLC donation brought our total raised to \$35,000 (\$70,000 after matching).

Our District's camp serves teens and adults with no maximum age. It is celebrating its 50th anniversary in 2024 and has always been managed with volunteers undertaking virtually all of the business management, planning and operational supervision. This "lean" organization has helped to keep our costs down but creates significant risk of continuity because of the dependence on year-round volunteers who essentially work full-time. We have also not employed professional fundraisers which can diversify our funding and provide opportunities to fund refurbishment projects in our 73-year-old facility.

When we achieve our \$100,000 fundraising objective, this "seed" money will enable the Foundation to hire 2-3 year-round staff members, one of whom will be our new Executive Director/Fundraiser. That individual will be expected to raise enough money from previously untapped sources to cover the cost of this additional year-round staff plus provide significant additional income to help pay for facility projects.

We thank those Clubs, Lions and others who have donated to the 50:50 campaign and we hope to achieve our \$100,00 goal soon so that we can proceed to take the next step in our leadership transition.

Save the afternoon of Saturday, June 22nd when we will be celebrating our 50th anniversary with past and present campers, seasonal staff, Lions, other volunteers and donors. Watch for the announcement in the next couple of weeks. - Lion Don Webster
