Cold Italian Beet Salad

Ingredients:

1 pound beets, about 3-4 medium beets, washed and scrubbed

1/4 cup extra virgin olive oil

1 small red onion, sliced

2 cloves garlic, minced

1/4 cup fresh mint leaves, minced

1/4 cup other fresh herbs, minced, if you have them

1/2 teaspoon salt


1/2 teaspoon powdered ginger

1/2 teaspoon sugar

1/4 teaspoon black pepper

3 tablespoons red wine vinegar

1 tablespoon balsamic vinegar



Directions:

Place whole beets in a medium to large saucepan and cover with salted water by 2 inches. Bring to a boil and simmer, covered and cook until beets are fork tender, about 30 minutes. Remove beets as they're done and immediately plunge in ice water to easily slip off skins. Take the cooled beets and place them in a paper towel. Cradle the beets in your hands to remove the skins. Slice the beets into round slices about 1/4 inch thick and transfer to a large mixing bowl. Add the remaining ingredients to the bowl and toss to combine. Let the salad marinate in the refrigerator for at least 30 minutes before serving.
