Thank you for registering for the Bellingham Central Lion's Junk in the Trunk garage sale! We are excited to offer this community event and are looking forward to working with you.

### **SET-UP:**

- 6:30A-8:45 A - All vehicles must be checked in and parked by 8:45A NO exceptions.
- Sellers must setup and be ready by 8:45 A - The sale begins at 9:00 A and ends at 2 PM.
- If you have someone you want to set up next to, please arrive at same time so we can park you next to each other. We will NOT be able to hold places.
- Vehicles parked in the sale area MUST remain until the end of the event (2 PM). No vehicles will be allowed to drive into sale area after 8:45 A.
- This event will run rain or shine. There will be no refunds issued for no shows.

### **SELLERS RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Sellers are responsible for loading, unloading setting up and cleaning up their space. We do not provide tables, chairs, or tents for this event.
- Sellers are responsible for providing their own change bags, pricing of items, and collection of money. Please bring change and bags for purchases.
- Any unsold items must be loaded back up and removed from area by 3 PM.
- Your parking spaces must be clean before you leave.
- Items for sale must be appropriate as this is a family event. We retain the right to ask you to remove items deemed inappropriate or offensive to the public. This includes weapons of any type.
- All items for sale must fit in the allocated parking space(s) provided.
  - ~ Standard space 16' X 16' = 2 parking spaces (1 for car, one for stuff)
  - ~ Multiple spaces can be rented in two @ \$25
- Your space/vehicle must be supervised at all times. BCLC is NOT responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged items/vehicles.
- Our concession stand will be onsite for you and the public to purchase from.
